Here is all you need to make a fabulous game of Elgin Museum Bingo!

Simply print, cut and play – you can print directly onto card or print to paper and then stick to thicker card, like an old cereal box, to help your game last longer.

**How to Play:** Each player gets a game card and 8 tokens, all the object cards are placed face down. The youngest player starts by turning over an object card, players who have this object on their game card cover it with a token. Play continues, clockwise, until someone covers all the objects on their game card and shouts '**MUSINGO!**'.
