

Moray Society Prize Draw

The Prize Draw has been running since April 2000 and has raised over £8000 for Elgin Museum. This helps with the day to day running costs and the Society is very grateful for this income.

Organisation of the Draw

Draw tickets are strictly limited to Moray Society members.

Income from the sale of tickets is paid directly into the Moray Society Prize Draw account.

All proceeds are used for the exclusive benefit of the Moray Society.

Tickets are £10 each per annum and are valid for 4 draws.

Draws are held quarterly with prizes of £25, £15 and £10 respectively for the first 3 numbers drawn, in sequence, at each draw.

These prizes are based on an income of £1000 in tickets sold ie. 100 tickets.

Many members have annual standing orders with their banks, which greatly reduces our costs. Standing orders can only be amended or cancelled by the persons concerned.

Mandates for standing orders are available from the Museum, or myself, on request. Cash, or cheques made payable to the Moray Society Prize Draw, are also accepted.

There is no limit imposed by the Society on the number of tickets that may be held by individual members.
