

- 1)** ~~Victoria~~ Tea Pot. Produced in 1793. Earthenware. Decorated with the contrast of the French and British sides of liberty with on one side Britannia and on the other the monster of the French Revolution. Donated by Mr Priest from Lochside, Spynie in 1852. [\[ELGNM 1952.7\]](#)
- 2)** Victorian Bed warmer. Copper. On loan from Angela Ewing, volunteer.
