



Moray Society Prize Draw

The Moray Society Prize Draw has been running since April 2000 and has already raised over £8000 for Elgin Museum. This helps with the day to day running costs and the Society is very grateful for this income.

Organisation of the Draw

Draw tickets are strictly limited to Moray Society members (aged over 18). Income from the sale of tickets is paid directly into the Moray Society Prize Draw account. All proceeds are used for the exclusive benefit of The Moray Society and Elgin Museum.

Tickets are £10 each per annum and are valid for 4 draws. Draws are held quarterly with prizes of £25, £15 and £10 respectively for the first 3 numbers drawn, in sequence, at each draw. These prizes are based on an income of £1000 in tickets sold (i.e. 100 tickets).

Our preference is for payment to be made by annual Standing Order as this greatly reduces our costs. Standing Orders can only be amended or cancelled by the persons concerned. A Standing Orders mandate can be found below; alternatively you can set up the Standing Order yourself through online banking (please advise with your application if you choose this option of payment). Cash or cheques will be accepted as payment method if it is not possible to set up a Standing Order.

There is no limit imposed by the Society on the number of tickets that may be held by individual members.
