- have not received a caution or a conviction in a court of law of a serious criminal offence or any child related offence.
- are aware of your duties and responsibilities as a charity trustee set out in the Charity Commission guidance 'The essential trustee'

 and in terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005.
- have read and understood the Charity Commission's guidance on safeguarding duties for charity trustees (https://www.gov.uk/guidance/safeguarding-duties-for-charity-trustees).
- are not prevented from acting as a trustee by the Charities Act 2016 or the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 because you:
 - o have an **unspent** conviction for any of the following:

 - e) an offence of **contravening a Commission Order or Direction** under section 77 of the Charities Act 2011
 - f) an offence of misconduct in public office, perjury or perverting the course of justice
 - g) In relation to the above offences, an offence of: attempt, conspiracy, or incitement to commit the offence; aiding, or abetting, counselling or procuring the commission of the offence; or, under Part 2 of the Serious Crime Act 2007 (encouraging or assisting) in relation to the offence.
 - o are on the **sex offenders register** (i.e. subject to notification requirements of Part 2 of the Sexual Offences Act 2003).



- have an unspent sanction for contempt of court for making, or causing to be made, a false statement or for making, or causing to be made, a false statement in a document verified by a statement of truth.
- have been found guilty of disobedience to an order or direction of the Commission under section 336(1) of the Charities Act 2011.
- are a designated person for the purposes of Part 1 of the Terrorist Asset-Freezing etc. Act 2010, or the Al Qaida (Asset Freezing) Regulations 2011.
- have previously been removed as an officer, agent or employee of a charity by the Charity Commission, the Scottish charity regulator, or the High Court due to misconduct or mismanagement.
- have previously been removed as a trustee of a charity by the Charity Commission, the Scottish charity regulator, or the High Court due to misconduct or mismanagement.
- have been removed from management or control of anybody under section s34(5)(e) of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 (or earlier legislation).
- are disqualified from being a company director, or have given a disqualification undertaking, and leave has not been granted (as described in section 180 of the Charities Act) for you to act as director of the charity.
- o are **currently declared bankrupt** (or subject to bankruptcy restrictions or an interim order).
- have an individual voluntary arrangement (IVA) to pay off debts with creditors.
- o are subject to a moratorium period under a **debt relief order**, or a debt relief restrictions order, or an interim order.
- are subject to an order made under s.429(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986.
 (Failure to pay under a County Court Administration Order).
- will inform The Moray Society promptly if, after the date of this declaration, one or more of the disqualification reasons applies to you.
- give your consent for TMS to carry out relevant checks including, if necessary, identity checks, Disclosure and Barring Service (previously CRB) checks and checks against the Charity Commission's and Office of the Scottish Charities Regulator's lists of removed or disqualified trustees.



- undertake to fulfil your responsibilities and duties as a trustee of TMS in good faith and in accordance with the law and within the objects and mission of TMS.
- understand that all trustees of TMS must sign and comply with the TMS Trustee
 Board Code of Conduct and must complete a Declaration of Interests form, which may be made available to members of the public on enquiry.
- understand that it is an offence under section 60(1)(b) of the Charities Act 2011 and undersection 26 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 to knowingly or recklessly provide false or misleading information.
